has a practical way for Americans
to help those imprisoned for Christ.

The website has profiles of people
who are imprisoned and why.
There is also a link where you can
write a prisoner a letter. But the
cool thing is the way you write the
letter. There is a list of several
phrases and verses in English
which you can choose 12 of in any
order. Then it prints in both Eng-
lish and the prisoner's language.
So it is easy to "write" to them.

You can then just cut off the bot-
tom of the page which has the
VOM website information and mail
it to the address they provide. You
can also include personal notes at
the bottom and photos/cards if you
want. When these letters are sent
to the prisoners, they can be en-
couraging (as long as they actually
receive them) and this can also put
pressure on the authorities --
knowing that the prisoner's story is
being followed in America.
